British Prototype Cup Overview



The Prototype Cup is a British prototype series, run by Bute Motorsport, organisers of the successful GT Cup championship. Having paid close attention to the development of the prototype formula and its growth over the past few years, the Prototype Cup has been established. The series is aimed at one or two driver line ups aspiring to race Le Mans Prototype machinery in a competitive national series in the UK.



LMP3 – A global series



The British Prototype Cup is an ACO-approved series (Automobile Club de l'Ouest). The ACO is the promoter of the Le Mans 24 Hours, European Le Mans Series, Asian Le Mans Series and the Michelin Le Mans Cup. The British Prototype Cup is designed as a feeder series for any of the ACO-promoted championships.

The LMP3 category is now a worldwide class and will be eligible to race in the US from 2017 after IMSA accepted the class into their race programmes.



British Prototype Cup Provisional Calendar



The 2017 British Prototype Cup season will visit four of the best UK circuits, with an overseas race at the world famous Spa Francorchamps circuit in Belgium and two trips to Donington Park. The race at Spa is still to be confirmed.
